PEDESTRIAN KILLED WHILE CROSSING OLIVE AVENUE

DATE: July 29, 2013

On Sunday July 28, 2013 at 10:02 p.m., Burbank Police officers responded to the 2600 block of Olive Avenue, regarding a report of a vehicle versus pedestrian traffic collision.

Fire Department personnel began life saving efforts and transported the victim to Holy Cross, where he later succumbed to his injuries.

The victim was identified as Brad Hensley, a 53 year old resident of the City of Maywood.

The driver of the vehicle, Ralph Neighbour, a 60 year old resident of Burbank, remained at the scene after the accident. He was subsequently released after being interviewed by Traffic Investigators from the Burbank Police Department.

The Los Angeles County Coroner's office and the Burbank Police Department Traffic Bureau are continuing the investigation. Anyone who may have witnessed the collision or who may have information concerning the investigation is asked to contact Detective Ken Schiffner at 818-238-3100.
