PEDESTRIAN STRUCK & IN CRITICAL CONDITION

DATE: June 2, 2016

On June 1, 2016, at about 8:50 pm, Burbank Police Officers responded to Riverside Drive and Niagara Street, regarding a traffic collision involving a pedestrian and a vehicle.

Arriving officers and Burbank Fire Department personnel treated the pedestrian at the scene. The 55 year-old man, who is a Burbank resident, was transported to a local trauma center by paramedics, where he remains in critical condition with significant injuries to his head and lower body.

The driver of the vehicle, a female in her 30's, who struck the pedestrian, remained at the scene. The driver was cooperative with officers and voluntarily submitted to field sobriety tests. The officers determined the driver was not under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

This collision remains under investigation by Burbank Police Traffic Bureau Detectives. Anyone who witnessed the incident is asked to contact investigators at (818) 238-3100 or Crime Stoppers at 800-222-TIPS (8477) to remain anonymous.
