## BURBANK POLICE OFFICERS' ASSOCIATION AND THE BURBANK PD COMMAND STAFF DONATE \$1500 TO BURBANK TEMPORARY AID CENTER

On November 17, 2015, the Burbank Police Officers' Association and the Burbank Police Department Command Staff presented Burbank Temporary Aid Center (BTAC) Executive Director, Barbara Howell a check for \$1,500. Between Thanksgiving and Christmas, BTAC will distribute more than 1,000 turkeys, serving over 500 households in Burbank.

BTAC has already begun distributing Thanksgiving food, but the most intense time will begin this week and continue through mid-day on Wednesday, November 25th. The holiday food consists of the "traditional" items of turkey, hams, stuffing, potatoes and pies, etc.

BPOA President Lieutenant Jay Hawver commented, "We are happy to be part of such a worthwhile endeavor. Helping those in our community who need it most is important to our membership." Police Chief Scott LaChasse said, "The Command Staff is overjoyed to be able to partner with the BPOA to help make this donation to BTAC, supporting families during the holiday season."

Burbank Temporary Aid Center is dedicated to provide the poor, working poor and homeless of the local community with basic services they need to live with dignity and to serve citizens of the city in times of emergency and disaster.
