## CRIME ALERT DAYTIME RESIDENTIAL BURGLARIES

Recently, during the late morning and early afternoon hours, there have been a few attempted residential burglaries in the area.

In one situation, the victim heard the suspect begin to knock on the front door of her townhouse. The victim did not answer the door, however, she saw the suspect on her porch. The suspect continued to knock and ring the doorbell before leaving the location, but returned a few minutes later and again began knocking on the door, ringing the door bell, and pounding on the door. At one point when the knocking stopped the victim heard the suspect using a drill on her door. The suspect did not make entry and fled in an unknown direction.

The suspect is described as a male, Hispanic or Armenian, with olive skin tone, partially bald with a bald spot on the top of his head, and light colored shaved hair on the side of his head, 5'05" to 5'06" tall, 150-200 lbs., and approximately 50 years old. The suspect was wearing jeans and a royal blue polo shirt, with possible white and/or gray stripes on it.

The Burbank Police Department encourages community members to always "answer the door," so people know you are home, but never "open the door," and possibly be the victim of a further crime.
