BPD INVESTIGATING DEATH OUTSIDE THE JOSLYN CENTER

DATE: October 13, 2014

Today, at approximately 2:08 p.m. officers responded to the Joslyn Center (1300 block of West Olive Avenue) regarding a female down on the grass. When the officers arrived, they observed a female, who appeared to be in her 30's, on the grass on the south side of the Joslyn Center. During the officers' initial contact, the female did not show any signs of life, and she was pronounced dead at the scene.

At this time there is no known cause of death. The initial investigation did not show any signs of trauma to the female. Burbank Police detectives are working with the Los Angeles County Coroner's Office to determine the cause of death and the female's identity.
