NIAGARA STREET INCIDENT INVESTIGATION

DATE: June 16, 2018

Burbank, CA

On June 15, 2018, at approximately 10:23 pm, Burbank Police Officers were dispatched to investigate a reported restraining order violation at a house in the 1500 block of North Niagara Street. When they arrived, the officers heard shots being fired, and a fire was observed at the house. Officers made contact with three individuals at the house, and were able to evacuate them. These individuals confirmed that shots had been fired, and that the suspect was in the area. They were safely evacuated, and were not injured.

Officers in an Air Support helicopter working the call observed the suspect attempting to flee. A perimeter containment was established, and additional resources were dispatched. The Burbank PD SWAT team and K9 officers, with assistance from Glendale and Pasadena PD, conducted a search of the containment area.

At approximately 3:15 am, on June 16, the suspect was found in the backyard of a property in the 1400 block of Catalina Street. The suspect did not comply with directions from the officers, and a K9 was deployed. The suspect was taken into custody, and a firearm was recovered at the scene.

No shots were fired by officers during this incident. The suspect was transported for treatment of injuries received during his apprehension by the K9. Burbank Police Detectives are continuing to work an active investigation of this incident.
