OFFICIAL NEWS RELEASE FATAL TRAFFIC COLLISION

On October 30, 2015, at about 7:34 pm, Burbank Police and Fire Departments received calls from residents reporting a traffic collision. They reported a vehicle had crashed into an apartment building wall in the south alley of Santa Anita Street at Sixth Avenue.

When Police and Fire Department resources arrived on scene, they found a sedan had collided with the support pillar of an apartment complex' parking garage. There were four occupants in the vehicle.

The driver and front seat passenger, a male and female in their late 60s to early 70s, were transported to LA County USC with serious injuries. Both are stable at this time.

The rear seat passengers, a male and female in their 70s, were taken to SJMC in Burbank. Both rear seat passengers were pronounced deceased as a result of the collision.

The cause of the collision is under investigation. The Burbank Police Department is seeking the public's assistance. Anyone who witnessed the collision or has information is asked to contact the Burbank Police Department Traffic Bureau at (818)238-3100.
