## **ARRESTS MADE IN CONNECTION WITH** ATTEMPTED MURDER INVESTIGATION

October 29, 2021

Burbank, California - On October 28, 2021, at about 10:00 PM, Burbank Police responded to the area of Frederic Street and Chandler Boulevard after receiving multiple 911 calls of possible gun shots. Police arrived and found an adult male suffering from a gunshot wound to his arm. He was transported to a trauma center where he underwent emergency surgery. He remains in the hospital in stable condition.

Based on the Department's investigation, this was not a random act. It was evident the suspect and victim knew each other. Burbank Police identified the suspect as 37-year-old, Richard Dick V (the fifth) of Burbank, CA.

Mr. Dick was originally thought to have been hiding in a nearby residence where he has been known to reside with family. Police established a perimeter, and the home was checked, but the suspect was not located.

Early this morning, officers and detectives continued the investigation and located a vehicle believed to have been used to transport Mr. Dick away from the scene. A family member has been arrested on suspicion of aiding the suspect in his escape.

After further investigation, Burbank detectives located Mr. Dick at a residence in Burbank. Detectives arrested him without incident and booked him for attempted murder. He is being held without bail due to being on parole for an assault with a deadly weapon conviction from 2017. Detectives will present this case to the Los Angeles County District Attorney's Office for filing consideration.

The firearm used in the attempted murder, a 9mm semi-automatic handgun, is still outstanding. As this investigation is ongoing, no further information will be released at this time.
