## DRIVER DIES AFTER EXPERIENCING MEDICAL EMERGENCY

March 14, 2022

**Burbank, California** – A 69-year-old man involved in a traffic collision has died as a result of a medical condition while driving a motor vehicle.

On March 11, 2022, at about 7:10 PM, the Burbank Police Department responded to reports of a single vehicle traffic collision on Front Street, south of Burbank Boulevard. When officers arrived, they found the unconscious driver of the vehicle still seated in the driver's seat. Paramedics responded and performed life saving measures but were unsuccessful. The driver was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The driver has been identified as George Madoyan, a resident of Glendale, CA.

At this time, neither drugs nor alcohol appear to have been a factor in the collision. Preliminary autopsy results indicate Mr. Madoyan died as a result of ischemic heart disease and atherosclerotic coronary artery disease. It is believed Mr. Madoyan experienced a medical emergency while driving, which caused him to crash into a light pole.
