SHOOTING INVESTIGATION SUSPECT BEING SOUGHT

On Wednesday morning, December 9, 2015, at about 7:20 am, Burbank Police Officers responded to a residence in the 1700 block of North Catalina Street regarding a report of shots fired.

Upon arrival, officers found the resident, a 67 year old male, lying in his driveway, having suffered multiple wounds as a result of gunfire. The most significant of the wounds were to his abdomen. A second victim, a 33 year old gardener working nearby, was also found to have been shot in the foot. Both were transported to area hospitals. The resident underwent surgery and is listed in serious condition. The gardener is listed in stable condition and expected to be okay.

The suspect vehicle, which is described as a silver four-door sedan, was last seen driving south on Catalina Street, towards Victory Boulevard. The suspect is described as a male in his 20's, with dark hair.

Investigators are working to determine what the relationships are between the victims and the suspect.
