North Shore Animal League America's 2014 Tour For Life – the world's largest national cooperative life-saving mobile pet adoption event visited Burbank on May 4th to partner with the Burbank Animal Shelter for a special life-saving event. Four cats and three dogs were able to find permanent homes at the Tour for Life Event.

From the beginning of March to mid-May, Tour For Life will traveled the length of the United States from North to South and East to West in four "shelters on wheels," helping shelter and rescue groups in 52 cities and 26 states bring awareness to their organizations and find homes for the adorable adoptable animals in their care.

The world's most famous canine Scooby-Doo joined forces with North Shore Animal League America to invite students from local schools to celebrate by hosting a Mutt-i-grees Pack Party. The Pack Party offered special activities that aimed to raise funds and awareness to support its local shelters and Mutt-i-grees in-school curriculum programs that teach social and emotional learning skills by helping homeless animals.

The Fenton Charter Public Schools raising over \$3,000 to donate to the Burbank Animal Shelter. John Burrough's Habitat For Humanity Club and Animal Rights Club raised over \$1300 to donate as well. The Burbank Animal Shelter will use funds raised to help provide important services to the community and find loving homes for stray animals.
