July 30th marked the anniversary of BPD Fallen Deputy City Marshal, Robert L. Normand, End of Watch, July 30, 1920.

Deputy City Marshal, Robert L. Normand, was on-duty when he requested assistance from Constable, Henry Purrier, to check three men driving a vehicle without headlights. The two officers stopped the vehicle at Third St. and Tujunga Ave. As the officers approached, the occupants began shooting at them. Marshal Normand was killed instantly. Marshal Normand served Burbank from February 21, 1914 until his death.

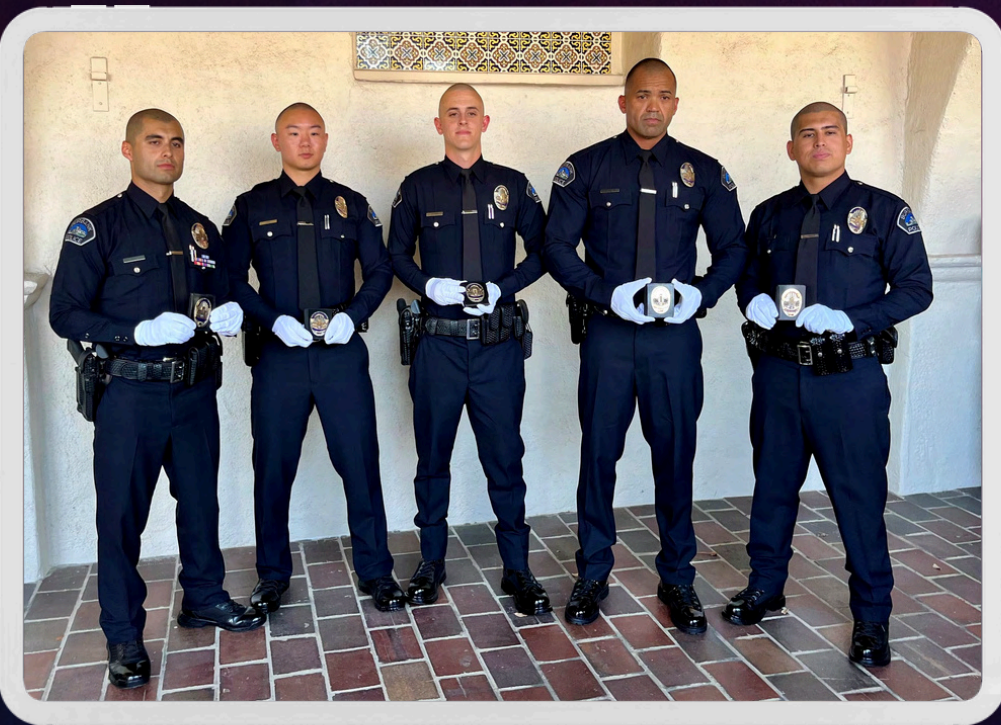

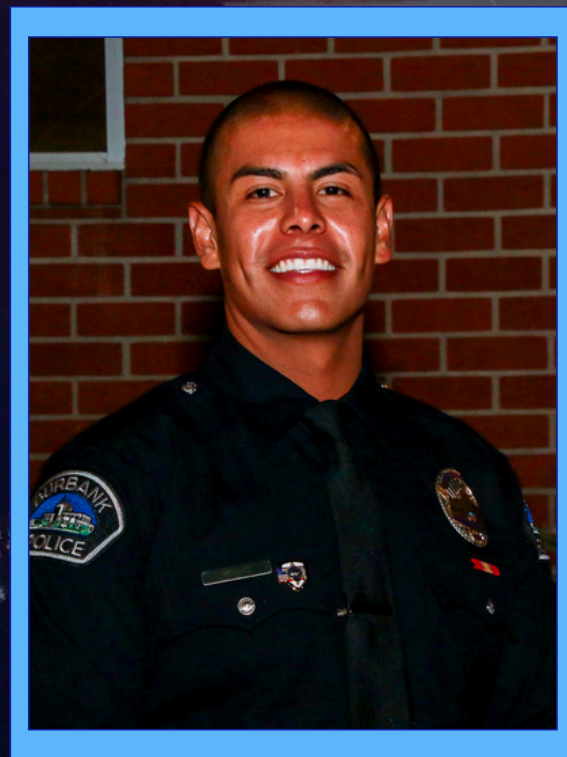

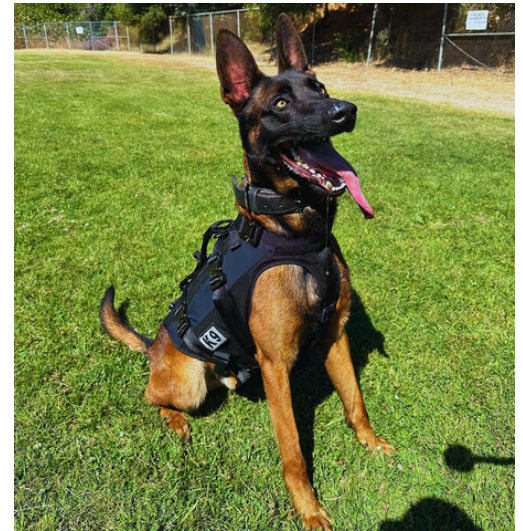
Officers Salas, Han, Rotter, Sena, and Piedra graduated from the Rio Hondo Police Academy on July 3rd.

Traffic Enforcement & Education

The Burbank Police Department is committed to ensuring the safety of the citizens in our community. Impairment, speeding, street racing, and other dangerous driving behaviors jeopardize the safety of other people on the road. Burbank PD continues to enforce traffic laws with the goal of reducing collisions, educating the citizens in our community, and keeping our community safe. This is achieved through the establishment of preventative patrols to manage specific categories of unlawful driving behavior.



Traffic enforcement strategies are based on collision data, enforcement activity records, traffic volume, and traffic conditions. Several methods contribute to our overall goal: arrests, citations, warnings, and education. Through these methods and efforts, we strive to educate our community on the importance of safe driving and we aim to keep our community safe.
