New Dispatch and Records System

Over the past two years, the Department has worked diligently to replace its outdated public safety technology suite. In our commitment to optimize on technology, we partnered with Versaterm and invested over \$5 Million to bring in modern technology and upgraded hardware for our Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) and Records Management System (RMS). The CAD system successfully went live on Monday, June 24th. The RMS will go live on Monday, August 5th.

PET SAFETY TIPS

Don't take your pets to fireworks displays. Loud noises and fireworks may frighten them. It's safer to leave them at home.

Keep your pets indoors, but avoid leaving them home alone. If you must leave them at home, consider keeping them inside of a soft pet crate. Also, leave the radio or television on to drown out any noise created by fireworks.

Make sure your pet(s) are wearing identification at all times. The Burbank Animal Shelter microchips pets for Burbank residents, so make sure your contact information and pet licenses are up-to-date.

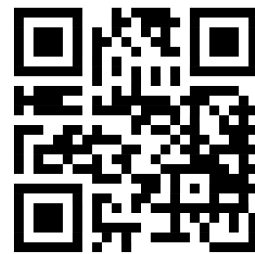
