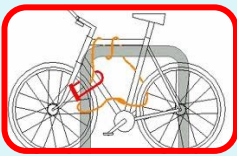

BICYCLE THEFT PREVENTION TIPS



As May is 'National Bicycle Month, here are a few theft prevention tips:

🚲 Always lock your bike

🚲 Always secure your bike even when at home

- Lock your bike when it's in an underground garage
- Don't leave your bike unsecured on your porch

🚲 Do not leave removable accessories on your bike. Take pumps, lights, and other accessories with you

🚲 Park and lock your bike where you see other bikes parked and/or seek lighted areas with foot traffic

🚲 Write down and store the make, model, and serial number of your bike

🚲 Ask your employer, your favorite shops, your building manager, and other places you visit on your bicycle to provide safe, weather-protected bicycle parking
