### RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY SUSPECTS ARRESTED FOLLOWING POLICE PURSUIT

September 29, 2022

**Burbank, California** – Five men from Los Angeles are in custody after committing a residential burglary and leading police on a pursuit Wednesday afternoon.

On September 28, 2022, at about 2:20 p.m., Burbank Police responded to the 1800 block of Catalina Street regarding a residential burglary in progress. The victim called the police and said she was not home but observed, via surveillance cameras, two men trying to break into her house.

The Burbank/Glendale Police Joint Air Support Unit arrived overhead and saw four men break into the back house of the victim’s property. The suspects then fled from the rear yard and jumped into an awaiting vehicle. It was discovered the home where the suspects were seen running from had in fact been burglarized.

Burbank Police Officers responded to the area and located the suspect’s vehicle, a grey-colored Ford Focus with stolen license plates affixed, entering the south Interstate 5 from Empire Avenue. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle, but the driver failed to yield, leading police on a pursuit. The driver of the vehicle committed numerous traffic violations and reached high speeds as it continued south on Interstate 5 and transitioned south on Interstate 110.

The pursuit came to an end when the driver stopped the vehicle on Interstate 110 and all five occupants exited, fleeing on foot.

A perimeter was established around the 900 block of Bernard Street in Los Angeles with the assistance of the Los Angeles Police Department. All five suspects were ultimately located and arrested, two of whom were located by a police K9 and bitten during the apprehension.

The suspects have since been identified as 20-year-old Joshua Harris, 20-year-old Zhorrie Cochran, 20-year-old Keyshon Walker, 20-year-old Rickie Chatman, and 19-year-old Jaylon Strickland, all residents of Los Angeles. All five suspects were booked for residential burglary and evading police, both felonies.

Formal charges are pending review by the Los Angeles County District Attorney’s Office.
