SUSPICIOUS POWDER

MAILED TO BURBANK PD – DEEMED SAFE

This afternoon at about 2:35 pm, a Burbank Police Department employee opened an envelope addressed to the police department. Upon opening the envelope, the employee noticed a white powder inside.

The Administrative Offices of the police building were cordoned off and the Burbank Fire Department responded with their Hazmat Team. Our partners with the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department Hazmat Team also responded. The powder was deemed safe and not hazardous at about 5pm this evening.

There were no injuries and there is no danger to any employees.

The Burbank Police Department will lead a multi-agency investigation, which will include the FBI and the United States Postal Inspector.
