BURBANK UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT EMPLOYEE ARRESTED ON SEX  
RELATED OFFENSES

DATE: June 18, 2015

Based on a report filed with the Burbank Police Department, Burbank Detectives conducted an investigation involving The Burbank High School Varsity Girls Volleyball Coach, Kyle Roach. It is believed that Roach initiated numerous sexually related text message communications with current members of the Burbank High School Varsity Girls Volleyball Team. Roach used text messages and social media phone applications, anonymously, to solicit nude photos from underage females.

Two Burbank High School students came forward when they began to suspect the communications were coming from their coach. The investigation resulted in the identification of an additional victim who claims to have had an ongoing sexual relationship with Roach while she was under 18. This victim is now an adult and no longer attends Burbank High School.

The investigation resulted in the arrest of 28 year old Kyle Roach of Glendale on June 18, 2015.

Mr. Roach was booked on the following felony charges:

288 a(b)(1) of the California Penal Code  
311.11(a) of the California Penal Code  
647.6 of the California Penal Code

Filing of this case with the District Attorney's Office is pending.

Due to the age of the victims, no further information will be released at this time.
