The Community Academy is designed to give individuals an opportunity to see how police officers work, as well as gain a better understanding of departmental operations. This course is designed to familiarize citizens with the department's community policing philosophy, internal policies, and the guiding principles of law and ethical conduct governing the delivery of police services within our community. Graduates of the Community Academy are eligible to become Burbank Police Department volunteers and assist Police personnel in the station. The length of the academy is 7 weeks. Classes are held once a week on Wednesdays from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.
