#### **Use of Force Continuum**

Officers shall evaluate each situation in determining the necessity for force and appropriate level of force.

#### **Duty to Intercede**

Officers observing force clearly beyond what is objectively reasonable shall intercede to stop the use of such force.

Officers should use deescalation techniques in order to reduce the need for force.

#### **Require Warning Before Shooting**

A verbal identification and warning shall precede the use of deadly force, where feasible.

#### Shooting at or from Moving Vehicles

Except in extraordinary instances, officers shall not shoot at moving vehicles or its occupants.

#### Use of Chokeholds / Strangleholds

Such force is not authorized. Existing policy covers the use of the carotid restraint to prevent death or serious bodily injury.

#### **Exhaust All Other Means Before Shooting**

Officers shall use other available resources and techniques, if reasonably safe and feasible.
