Lecture Discussion Instruction and Demonstration Practical Application	The Motor FTO will verbalize and demonstrate POST and additional cone patterns. The officers will then ride each pattern with trainer input as needed.
Test	Motor Officers will demonstrate proficiency in riding skills and ability to safely operate their assigned police motorcycles by successfully completing the following cone patterns: offset 90's, #3, circle, 180 decel, 40 decel, intersection, big O and figure 8, circle, snowman and mobile field force.
