All training will be performance oriented and SWAT task specific. Depending on the topic, team members will learn through lecture, demonstrations, and practical application. Some topics will require successful completion of a written exam. Monthly firearms qualification (handgun, rifle, and shotgun) will require team members to successfully pass the set course of fire.
