All training will be performance oriented and SWAT task specific.</p> <p>Depending on the topic, team members will learn through lecture, demonstrations, and practical application. Some topics will require successful completion of a written exam.</p> <p>Monthly firearms qualification (handgun, rifle, and shotgun) will require team members to successfully pass the set course of fire.</p>
