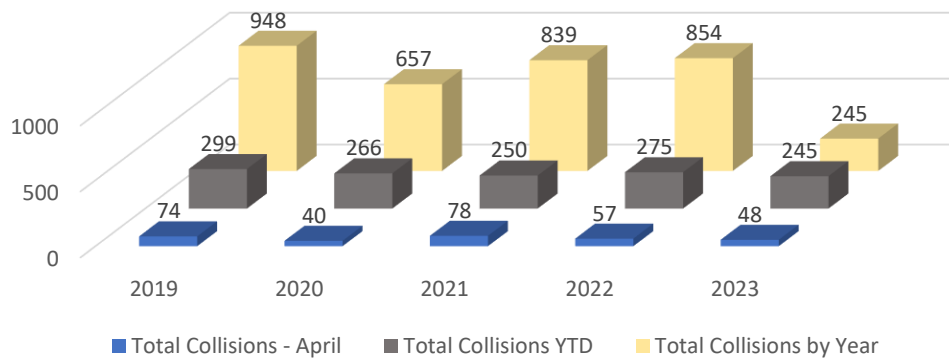

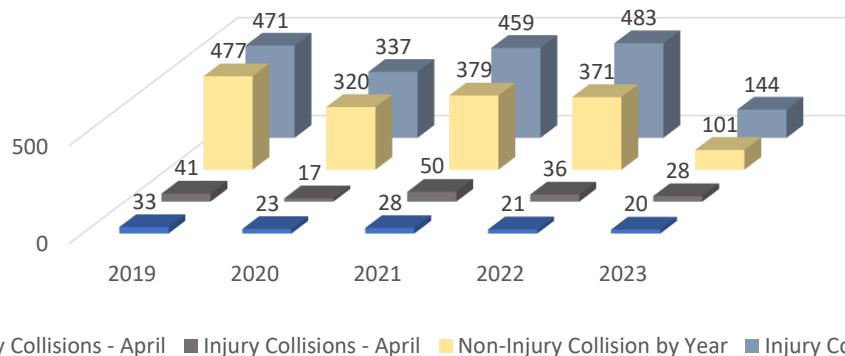

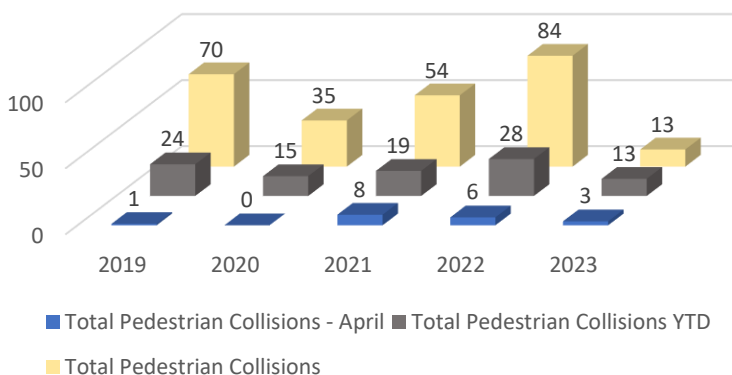
### Total Collisions 2019-2023



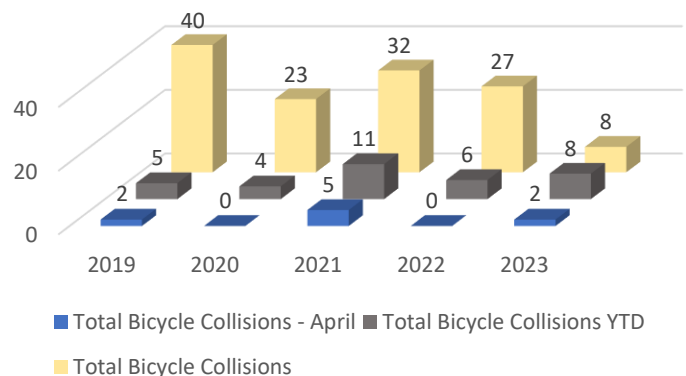
### Non-Injury & Injury Collisions 2019-2023

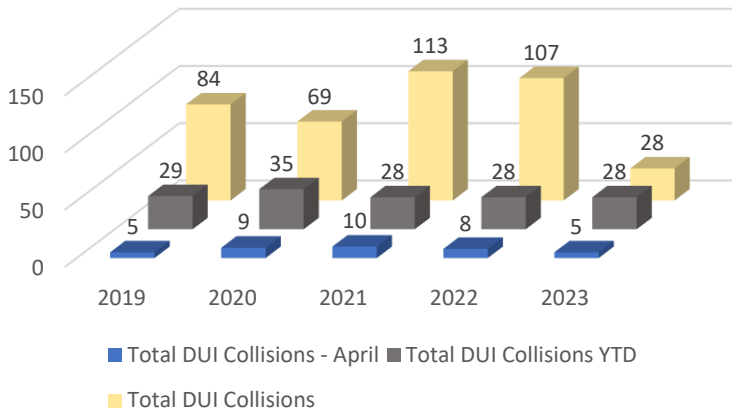

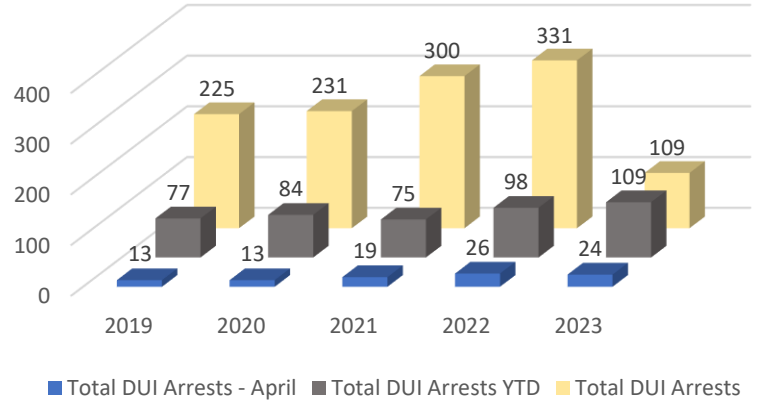

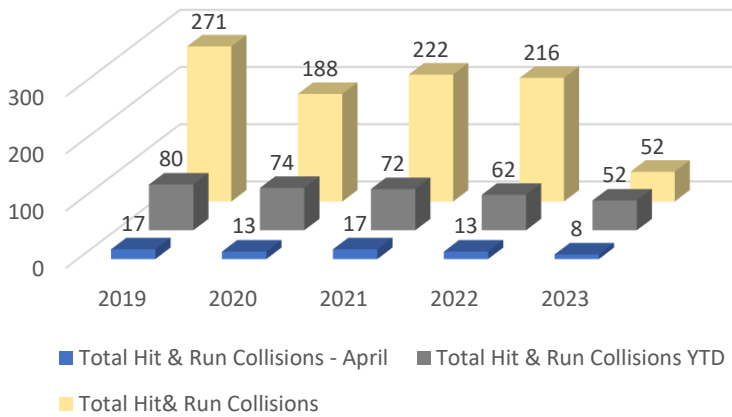
### DUI Collisions 2019-2023



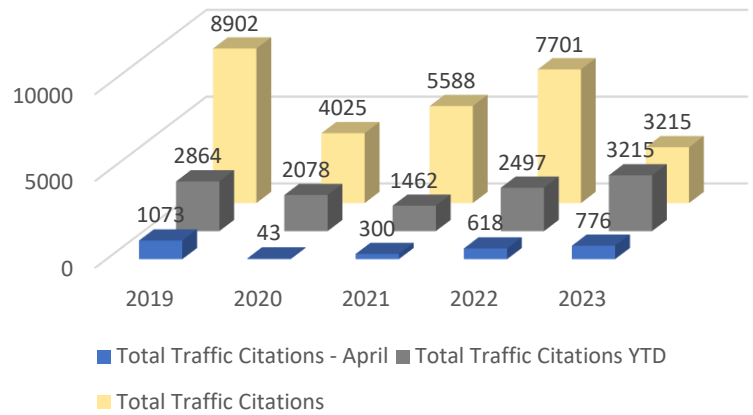

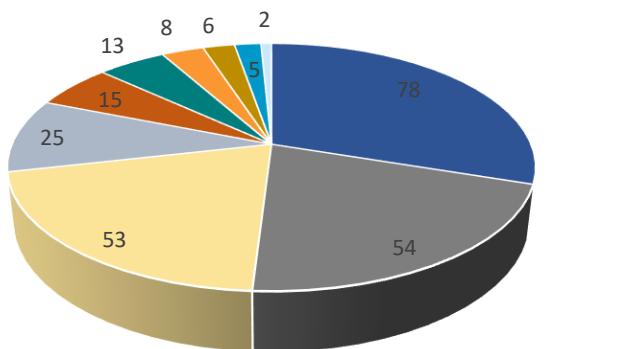

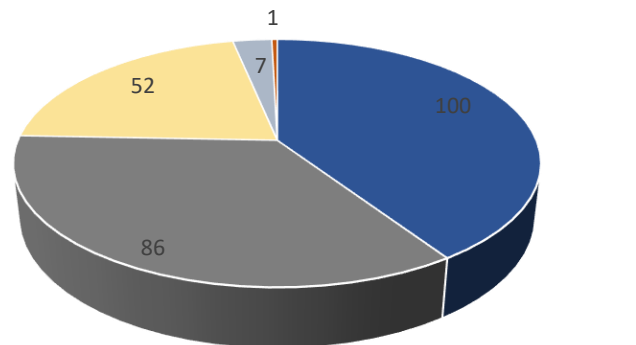
