IS YOUR YARD UNINVITING TO COYOTES?

HOMEMADE SOLUTIONS TO KEEP WILDLIFE OUT OF YOUR HOME GARDEN

WHEN TRYING TO RID YOUR GARDEN AND YARD OF RACCOONS, SKUNKS, OPOSSUMS AND OTHER WILDLIFE, YOUR BEST BET IS TO START OFF WITH SOME EASY HOMEMADE SOLUTIONS.



- Leave open jars of **vinegar** on the perimeter of where the animal is frequenting. Most wildlife do not like the smell and will try to avoid it. Leave the jars out for a few weeks, refilling them as necessary.
- Mix a bottle of **mint** extract oil into a large bottle of **mouth wash**. Soak rags with the solution and place in the area where the animal is a nuisance. The smell will be a deterrent, and is also beneficial in preventing rodents like mice and rats.
- A mixture of **cayenne peppers** and **onions** is also a good preventative for wildlife. The mixture can also be put in open jars and placed around your yard or garden. Wildlife do not like the Capsaicin active component in chili peppers which can cause a burning sensation if touched. Be sure to wear gloves and eye protection when working with the peppers.
- If the above suggestions do not help, you can resort to using **ammoniasoaked rags** in problem areas most frequented by wildlife. Ammonia gives off a strong smell which animals will stay away from, but can also be dangerous to people when inhaled. If you decide to use this as a deterrent, <u>use caution</u> when soaking the rags and always wear a mask and gloves.
- Movement detecting motion lights and/or motion sprinklers can be installed around your home to startle approaching wildlife. Animals will become wary of your home and learn to stay away. Inexpensive motion lights and sprinklers can be found online or at your local hardware store. Or, if you happen see these critters, use loud noisemakers (pots and pans work great) to make them uncomfortable and urge them to leave.
